I hope and pray that this letter finds you and your family doing well, and your 2023, is off to a great start. The new school year started for Sluys/Anderson primary and Hebron secondary (Form 1-4), on Monday, January 9th. We have several projects going on at the schools right now. Our project for the 60ft x 120ft multi-purpose/dining hall is finishing up with its foundation, and we hope to install the roof before March. The long Tanzania rains begin in March and end in May. The teachers' office space at Hebron secondary has been a very crowded environment, since 2011, when Hebron began. The teacher office spaces are being renovated to give our staff a more peaceful work environment, and some room to breathe. We are repairing some water infrastructure for the boys and girls' dorm rooms, and added a fresh coat of paint for the boys' dorm. At Sluys/Anderson primary school, the dining area has been repaired, and about 80 new desks for students were built.
