A very important value to this program is that every bit of your contribution is going to your child's education and livelihood. There are no administrative fees, and no paid positions on the United States side of the program. And, we would like to continue holding this value. Because of the cost increases of food, staff salaries, fuel, books, and general upkeep on the grounds; the Sakila Sponsorship board unanimously voted to increase sponsorship to \$38, per month, starting January 1, 2024. Throughout this change, we understand if you are unable to increase your sponsorship amount, so please feel free to continue with your current commitment.
