For the beginning of this new year, we have started some projects at Sluys/Anderson and Hebron schools. We are so excited for the \$31,000, that has been gifted towards a new building at Hebron. We are able to start laying the foundation and putting up walls for this 60ft x 120ft dining and multi-purpose room. We will need about \$15,000, to finish the roof. This will be a wonderful addition for the students, so that, they can eat out of the rain and bright sun. Also, it will be a meeting hall for the students and staff to gather for functions. We have another announcement for you about our secondary school (Hebron)! We purpose to have boarding for every student, starting January 2024. This will be a huge endeavor, however, it is necessary for every student to concentrate on their studies, and pass their national exams with high marks. Living on campus will give them access to electricity, study time, and the library. In addition to learning accessibilities, they will have three full meals a day. This past October, a generous donor gifted the exact amount to purchase the adjacent land to Hebron, in which God put it in someone's heart to sell this land to us. This purchase has given us the opportunity to build more dormitories, and housing for staff. For sponsors and supporters, if you have students moving on to Hebron Secondary (Form 1-6), we are not going to change sponsorship fees at this time. We have not done so in many years. Generous donors to the general fund and paying boarding students from out of the area, have helped to supply some of the needs of students that come from the SSP program (Sluys/Anderson Primary). We want to inform you that Hebron students in Forms 1-4, cost \$60, and Form 5-6, costs \$90 a month. God allowed this portion of ministry and education to expand so rapidly that we did not feel comfortable in asking sponsors to contribute more, if their student(s) moved on to High School and beyond. However, three meals a day, living expenses, more costly curriculum, higher educated staff, live-in staff, and medical care are the reasons for greater expense.
