The main reason for this gift is the appreciation for all their hard work and dedication to the kids in Sluys/Anderson primary and Hebron secondary schools. Here are a few pictures of some of the staff on the safari, and arriving early in the morning for the drive. All 85 staff members were not able to attend because of prior commitments, but they were very excited and thankful for this gift. I am told that most Tanzanians have never been able to experience a safari on their own soil. As we may know, these excursions can cost quite a bit of money. So, what a blessing for our staff to experience the outings that many of us are given the opportunity to experience.



### Housekeeping

- **All 38 Form 6 graduates passed their national exams.** In the Arusha region of Tanzania, Hebron ranks 17/36 schools with 30 or more candidates. In the nation of Tanzania, Hebron school ranks 258/644. What a praise! A total of 95,955 Form 6 students sat for their national exams this year. The country of Tanzania is a total population of 63,527,432.

- If you would like to send your student a correspondence letter for them to read or have someone read it to them, **please send to Jennifer Kamrath by the middle of September.**
- Thank you again, for your sacrifice in helping us purchase rice, beans, and corn. Please pray that we will be able to find beans at a closer location, and soon. Our drivers travelled 1800 miles round-trip to bring home 28,000 pounds of rice (Potentially another 100 bags at 220 pounds per bag, may be found). In addition, we have been able to purchase 70 bags of sunflower seeds to press for oil. **A side note: petrol is about \$8 per gallon in Tanzania right now.**
- I am still working on sending out your student correspondence, pics and updates to you. I endeavor to get this finished before the trip to Sakila in October. God-willing!! Thank you for your patience.
